Choice of Building Materials: We select materials considering safety standards, focusing on fire resistance, sustainability, and durability.

Process of Build and Structural Elements: Construction methods follow approved building practices, ensuring that structural design specifications are met to guarantee stability and safety.

The Company will give careful attention to its' Quality Objectives, which include safety, delivering on time and to budget, training of staff to industry guidelines, a high quality of work, and continual quality improvement. Quality Objectives will be set annually by the Safety & Sustainability Director, who shall monitor the company's progress against them. These shall be reviewed at the Annual Management Review Meeting, in order that they continue to reflect the Company's objectives. This is endorsed by the provision of a documented quality management system, which is subject to internal and external audit at regular intervals, in order to continually improve its' effectiveness.

MPB are certified to ISO 9001:2015. All relevant policies and procedures have been structured to meet the requirements of the standard. Each member of staff is aware of the Company's commitment to complying with the requirements of ISO 9001:2015 and are required to observe our quality requirements at all times. This Policy will be reviewed annually for its' continuing suitability.
